Examples include Chipping Away (their supplier) will offer club program members 10 % discount on most non-powered merchandise if you indicate you are a member of WWWCG, Bi-Monthly newsletter via e-mail. Discounts do not apply to certain items such as Festool, Saw Stop, Wood Items, Clearance or Sale and our Guild receives samples of products twice a year.

Of note, this is a Canadian company, so you should select U.S. prices when shopping to receive the excellent U.S. prices. The company does request a WWWCG membership list to provide the discount and names are not sold, distributed, or sent outside the program.
